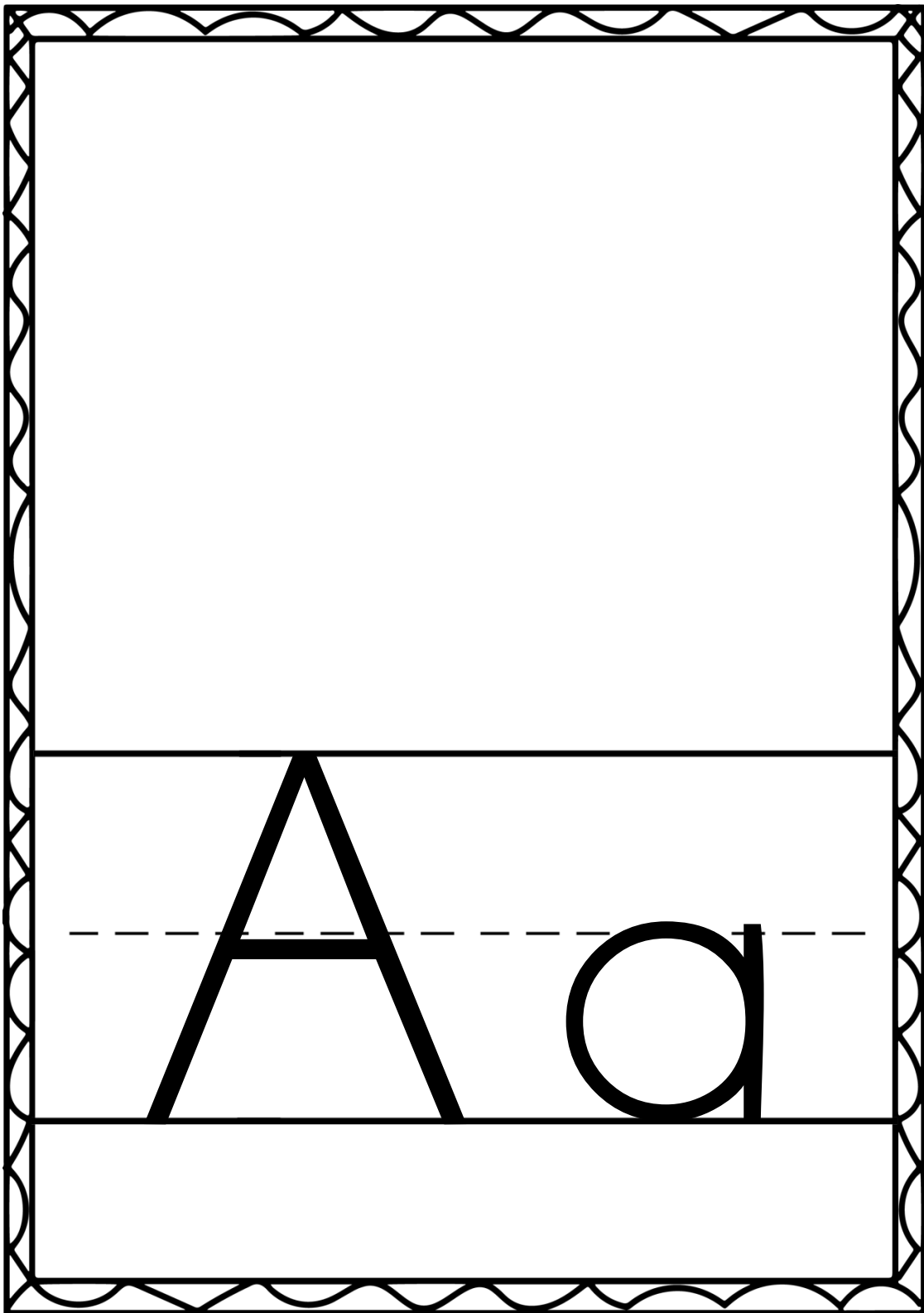
This student created alphabet is PERFECT for your classroom!

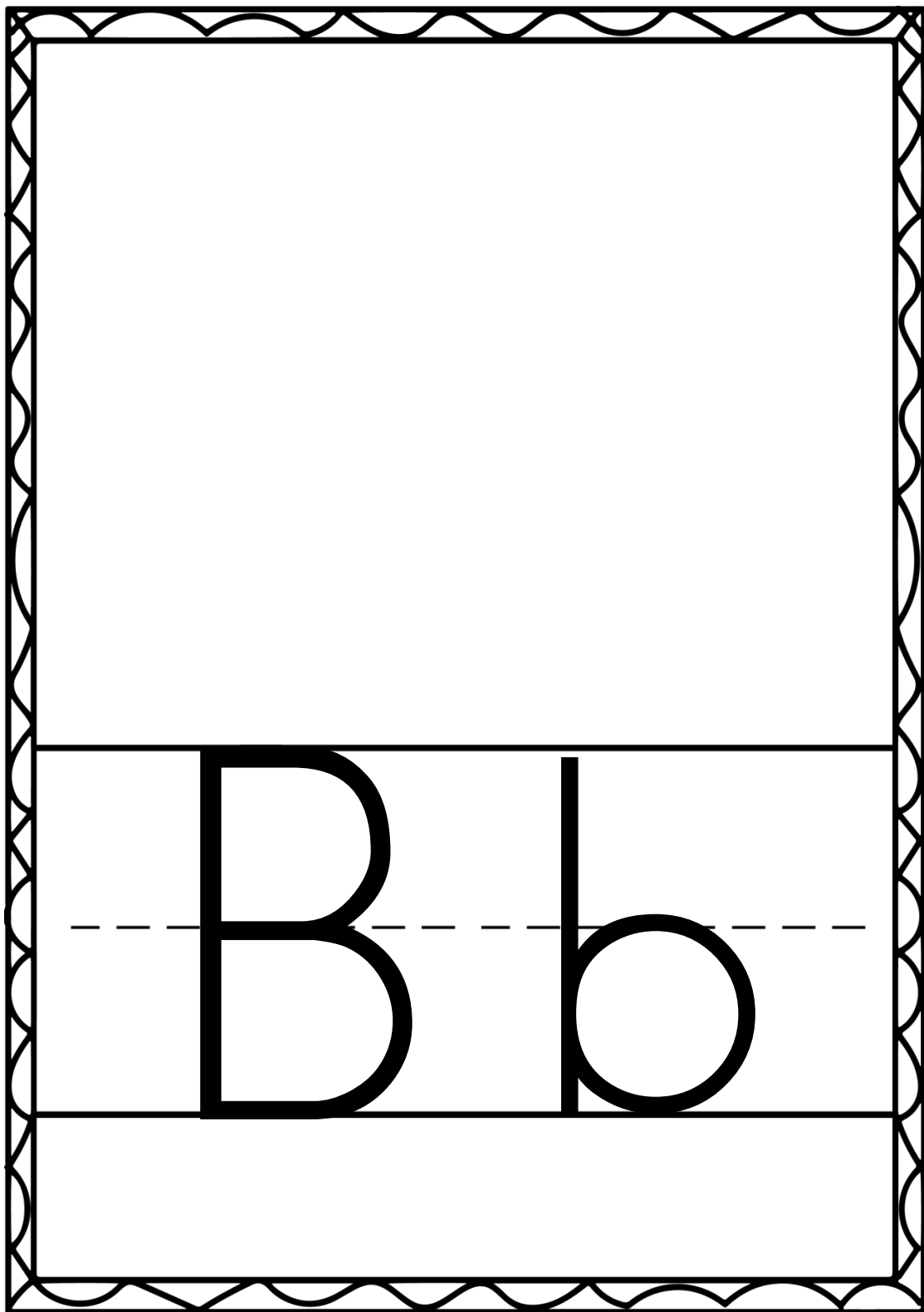
- fun way for students to refresh their memories for letter sound relationships.
 - easy to differentiate for students
 - students take ownership of things in classroom
- leads to students more inclined to use this "tool" (that they created) when learning ABC order, looking up letters to remember the sounds
- helps create a "kid friendly" classroom environment

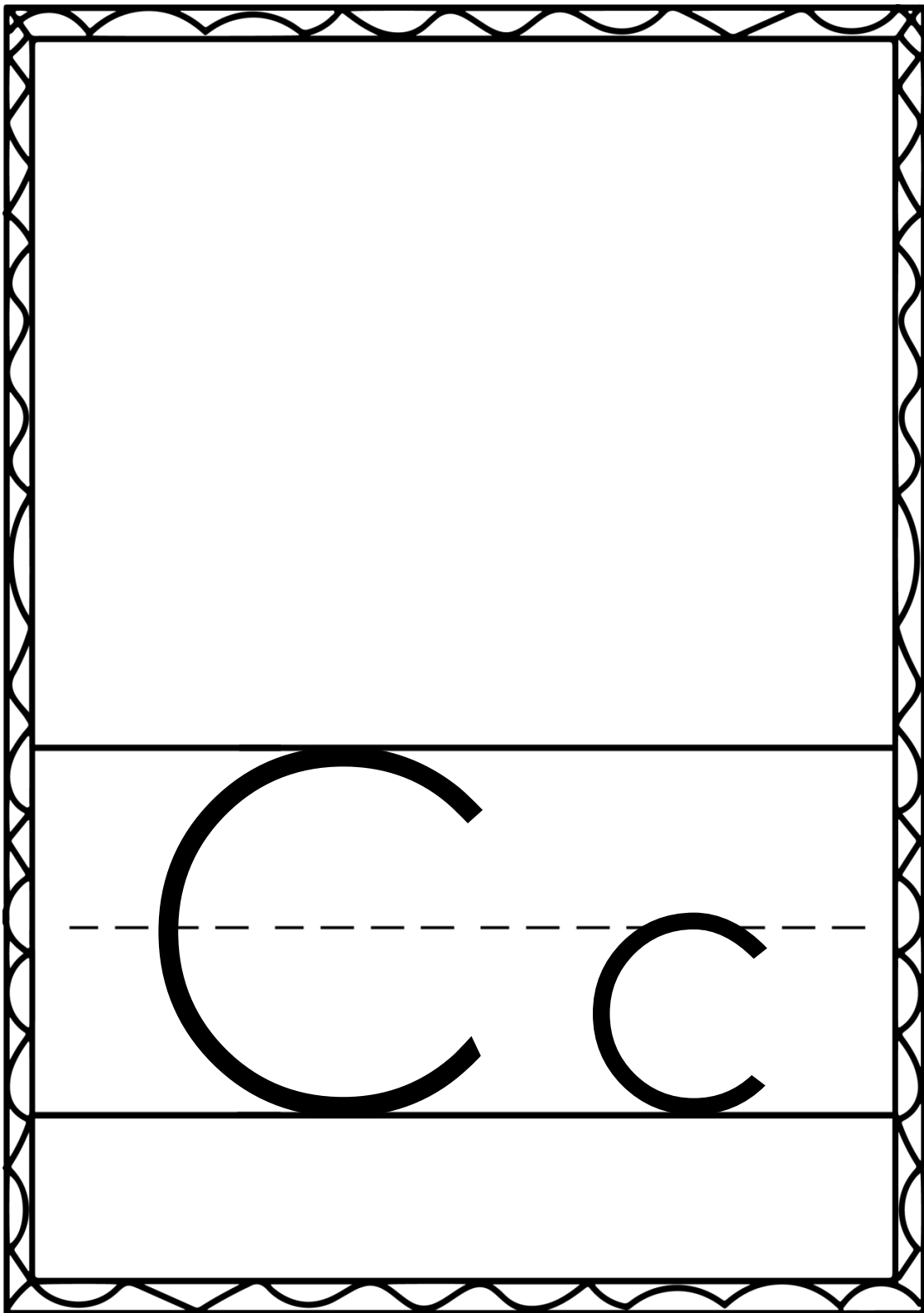
Note: Make copies to put into a class ABC book. Decorate the cover page of the ABC BOOK with pictures of things that were drawn.

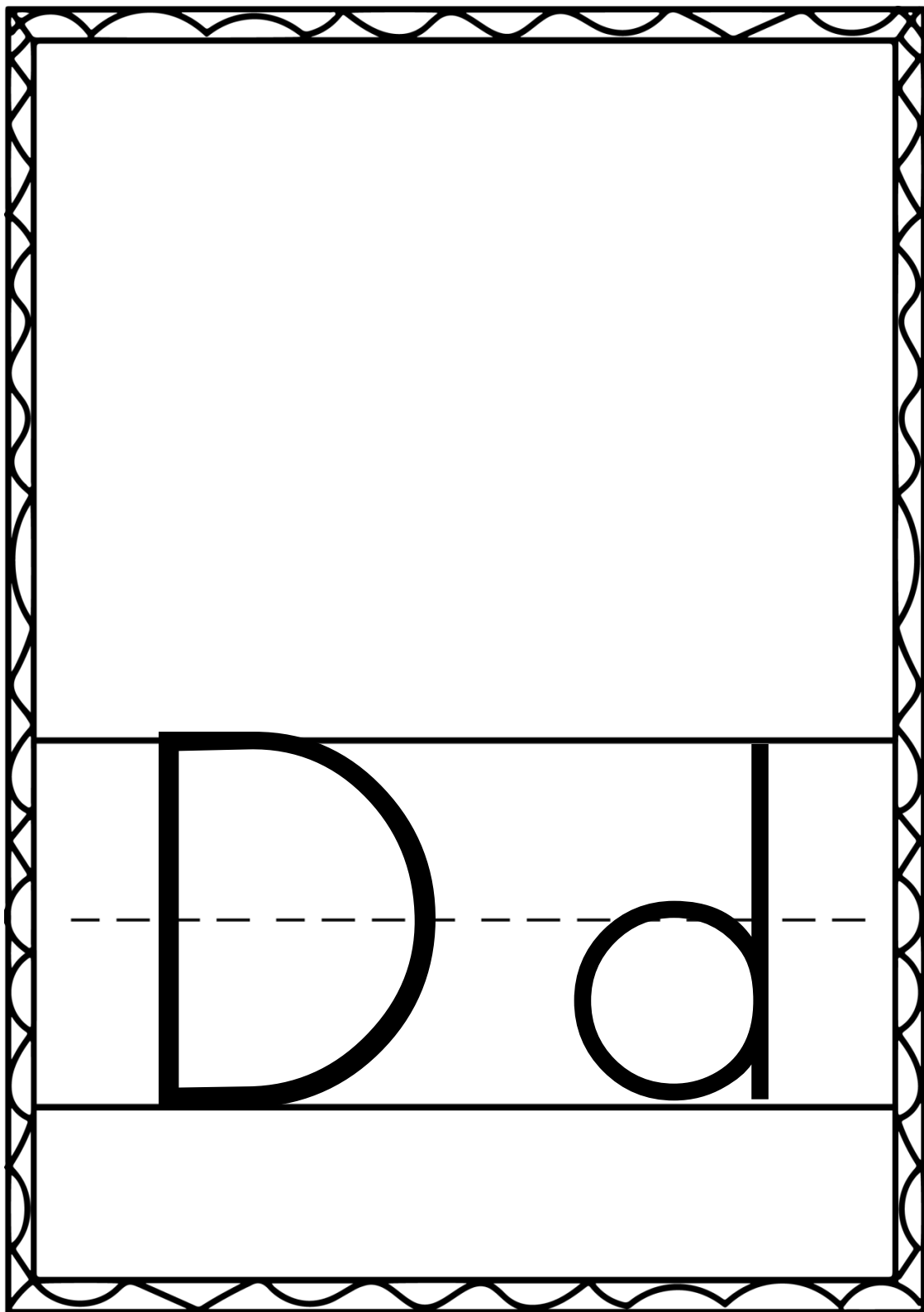
HOW TO

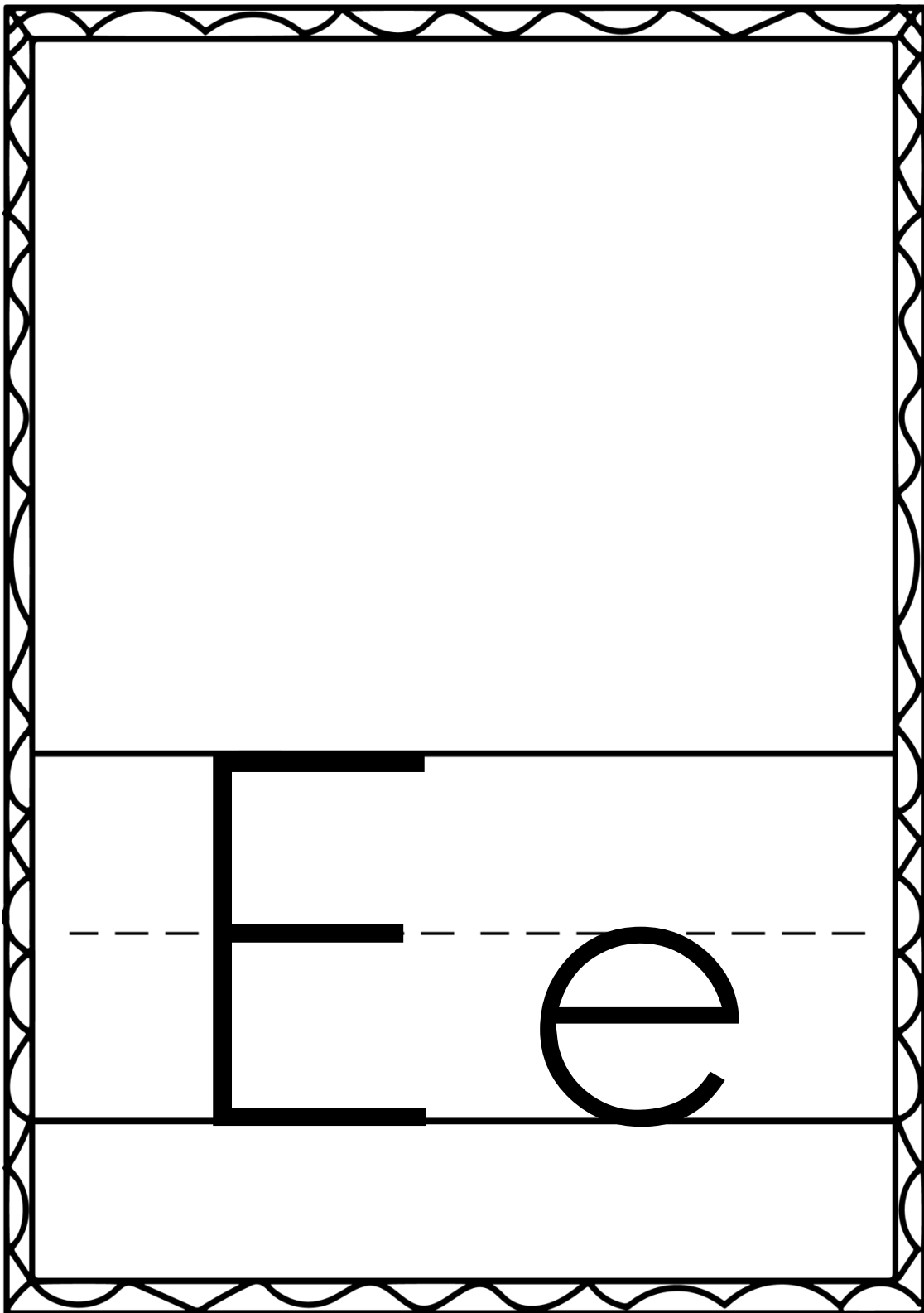
- Print off ABC paper on colored paper.
 - Print off small rectangle papers on white paper.
 - Assign students one letter from the ABCs.
- Give each student their assigned colored paper for the letter they were assigned.
 - Give the students one white small rectangle paper.
 - Have students draw a picture of something that starts with their letter.
 - Label the picture with black crayon.
- Glue white paper onto colored paper.
 - Note: I let my students use phonetic spelling when labeling the picture- your choice!

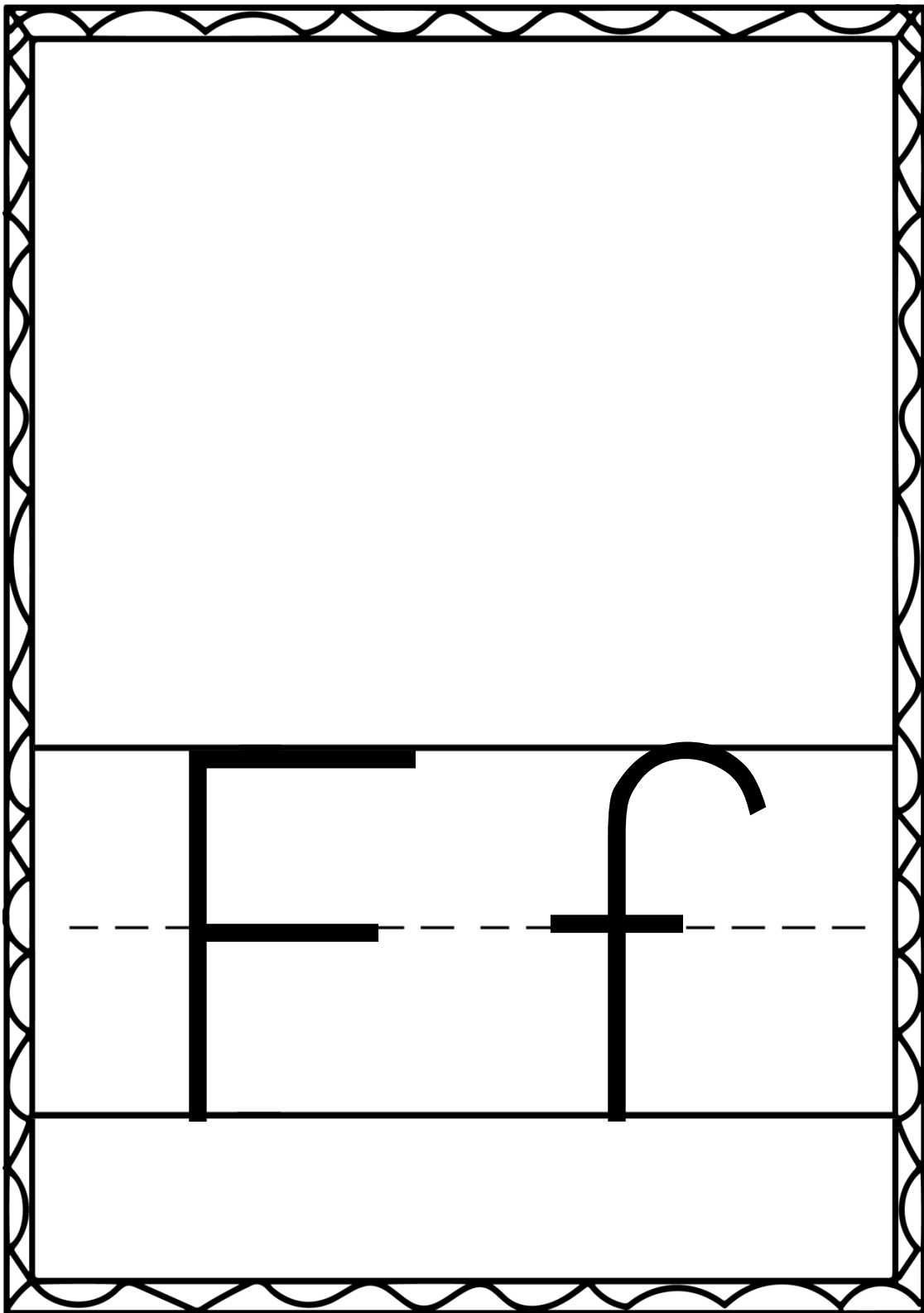


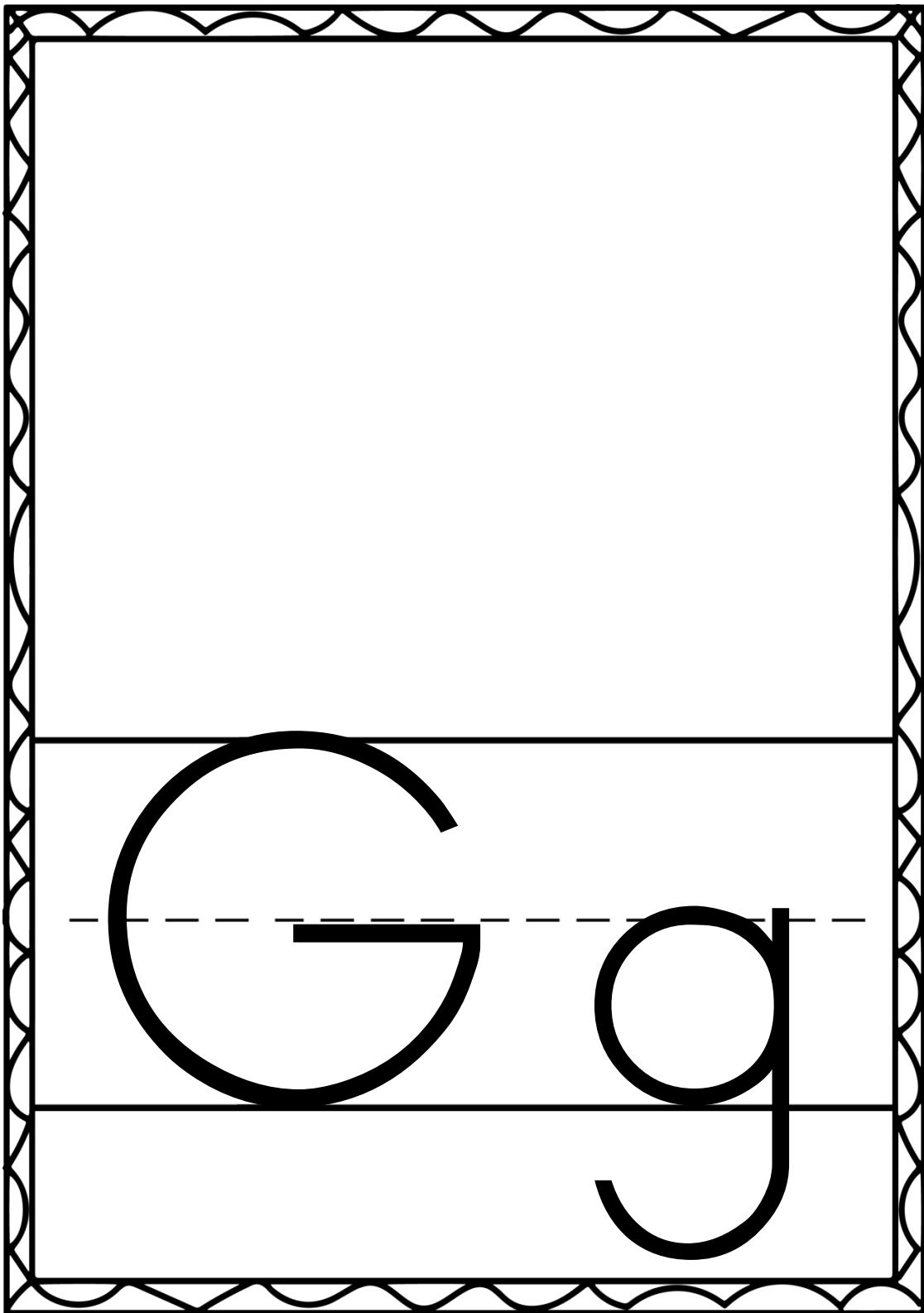


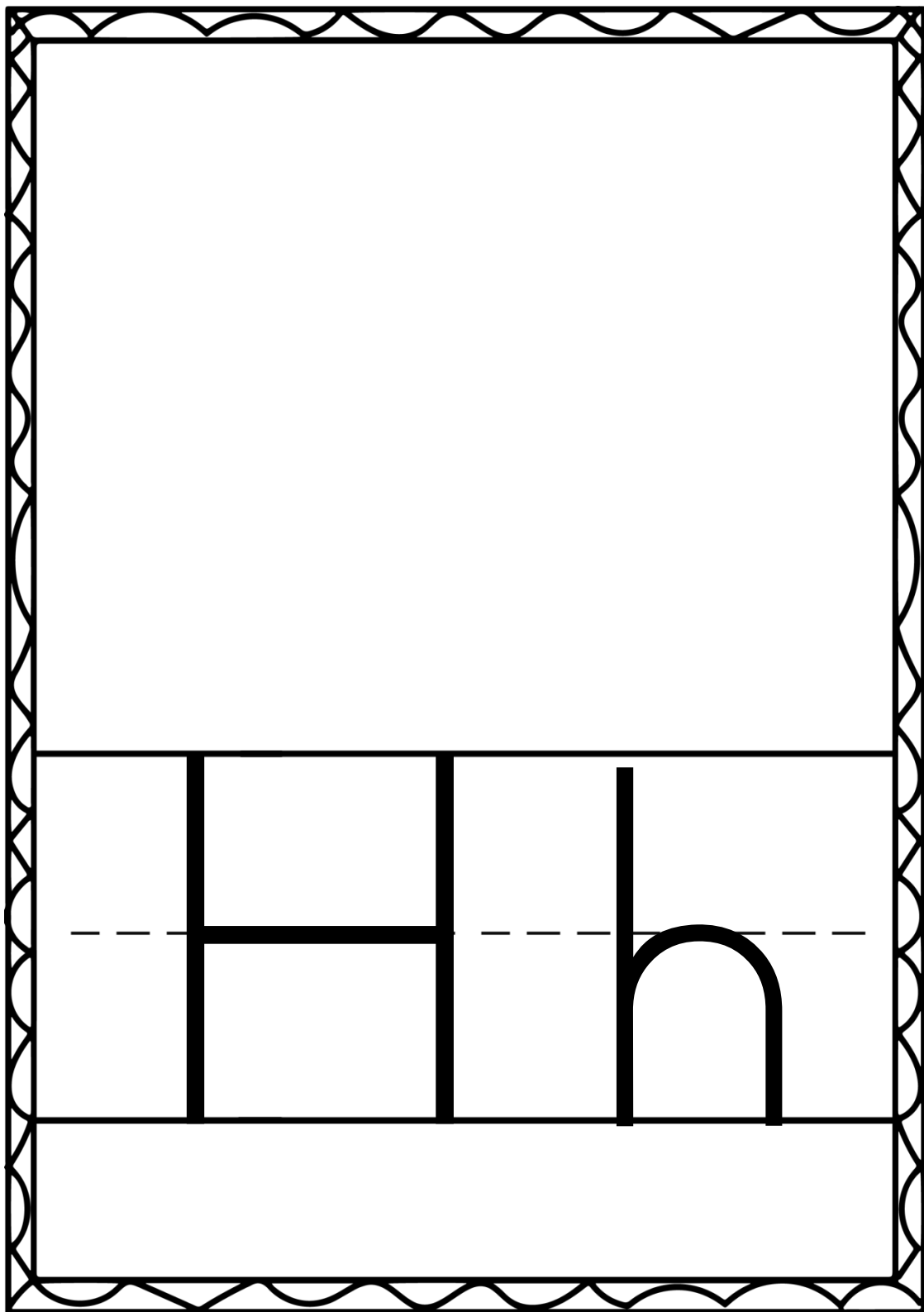


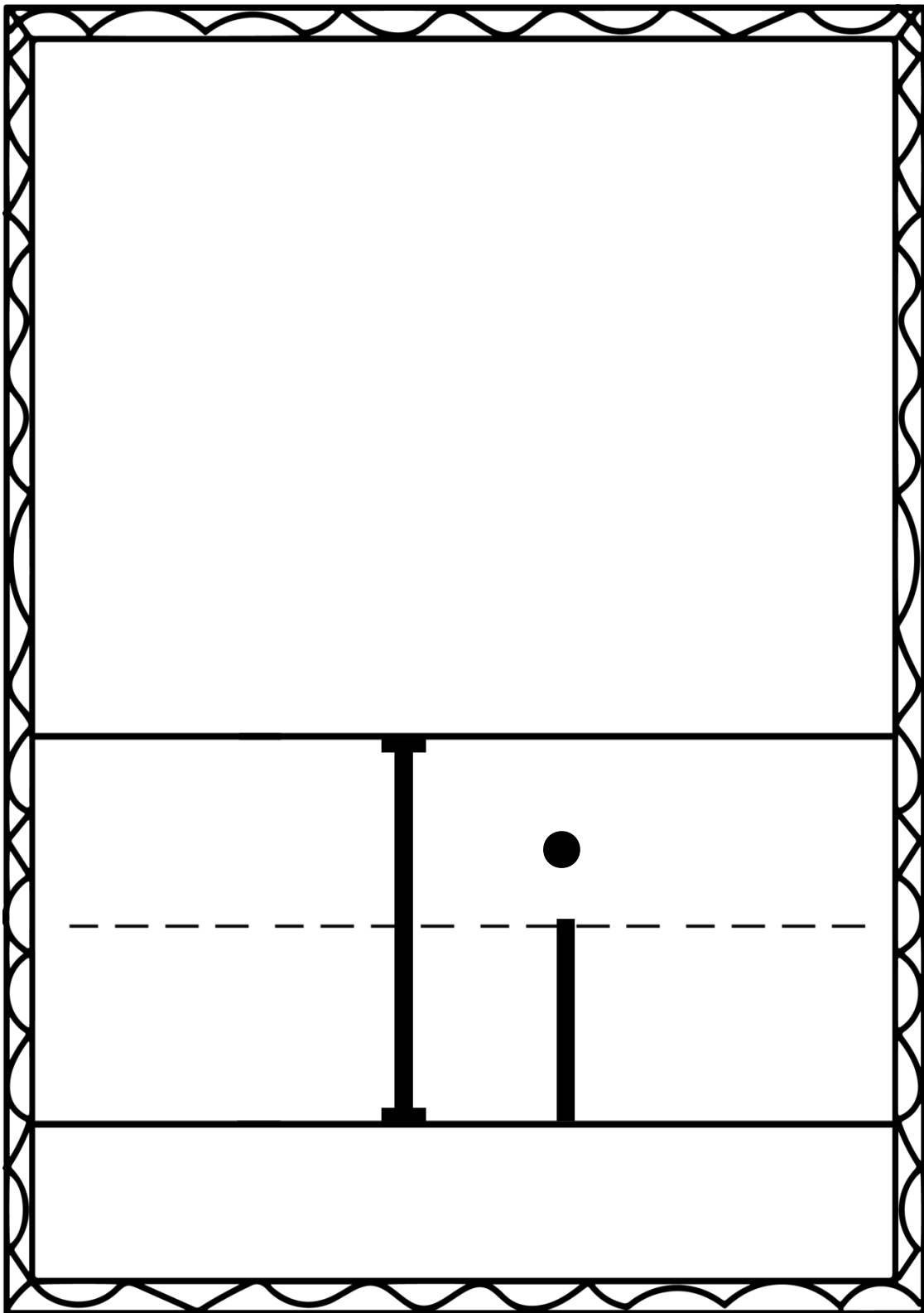


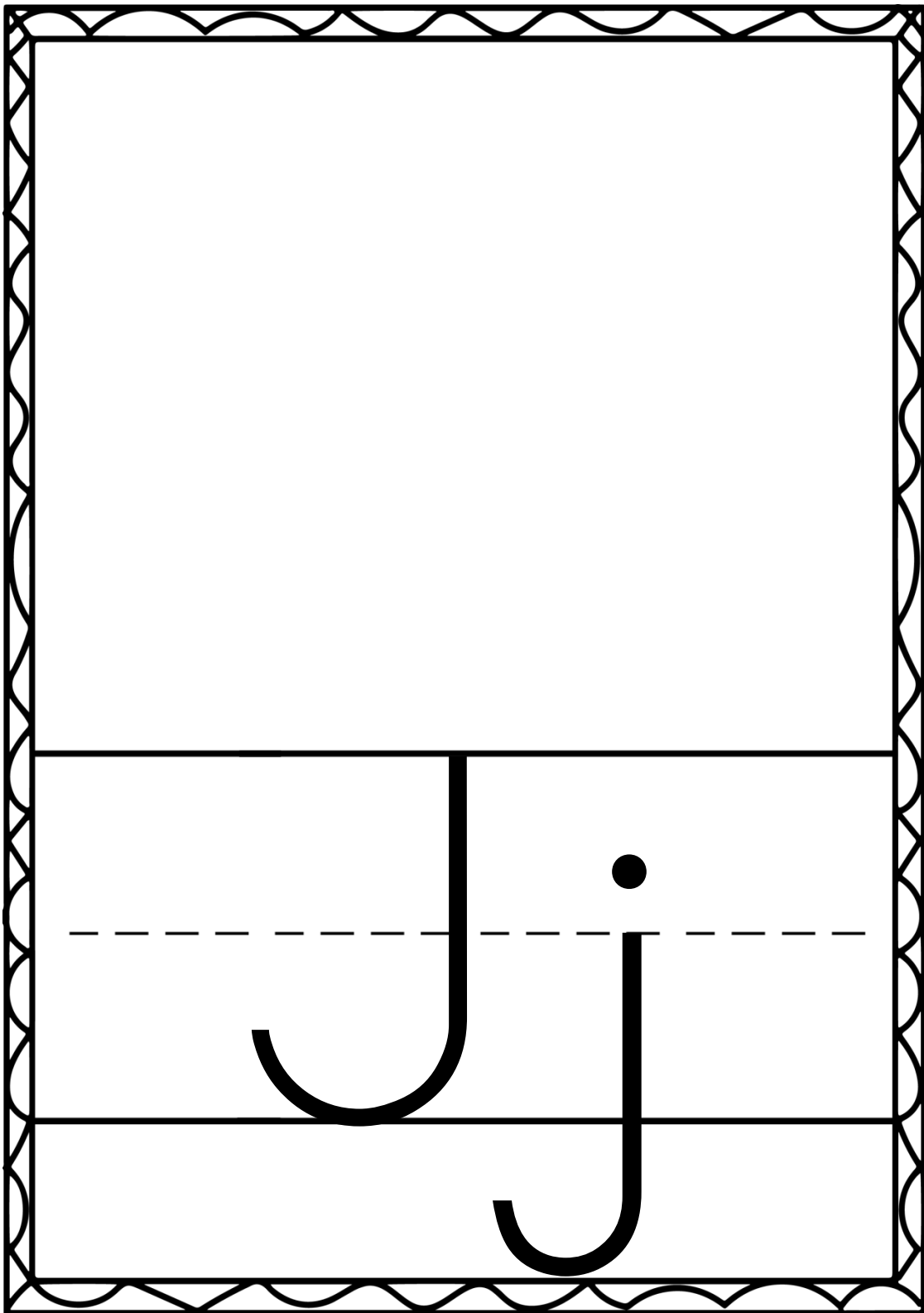


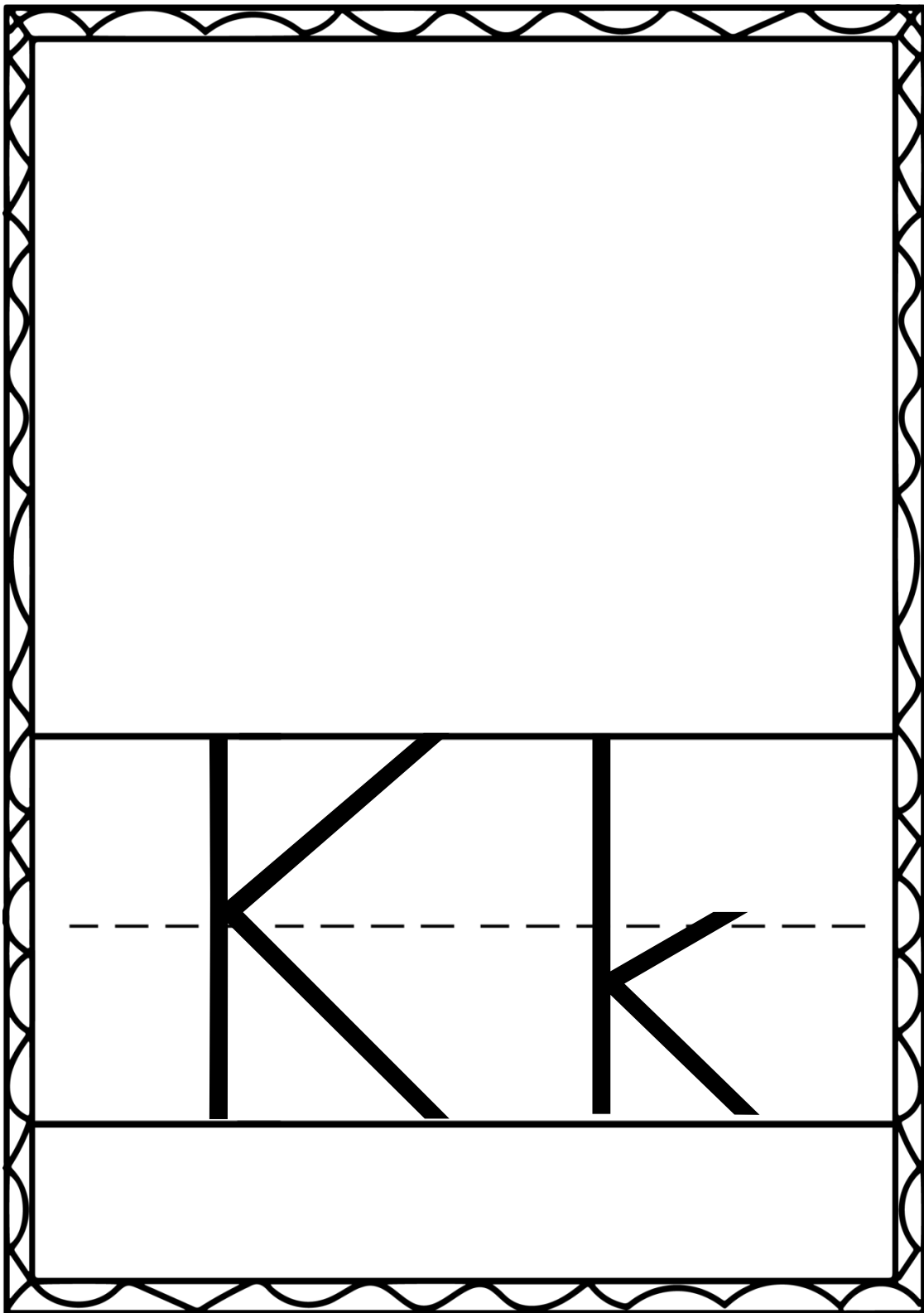


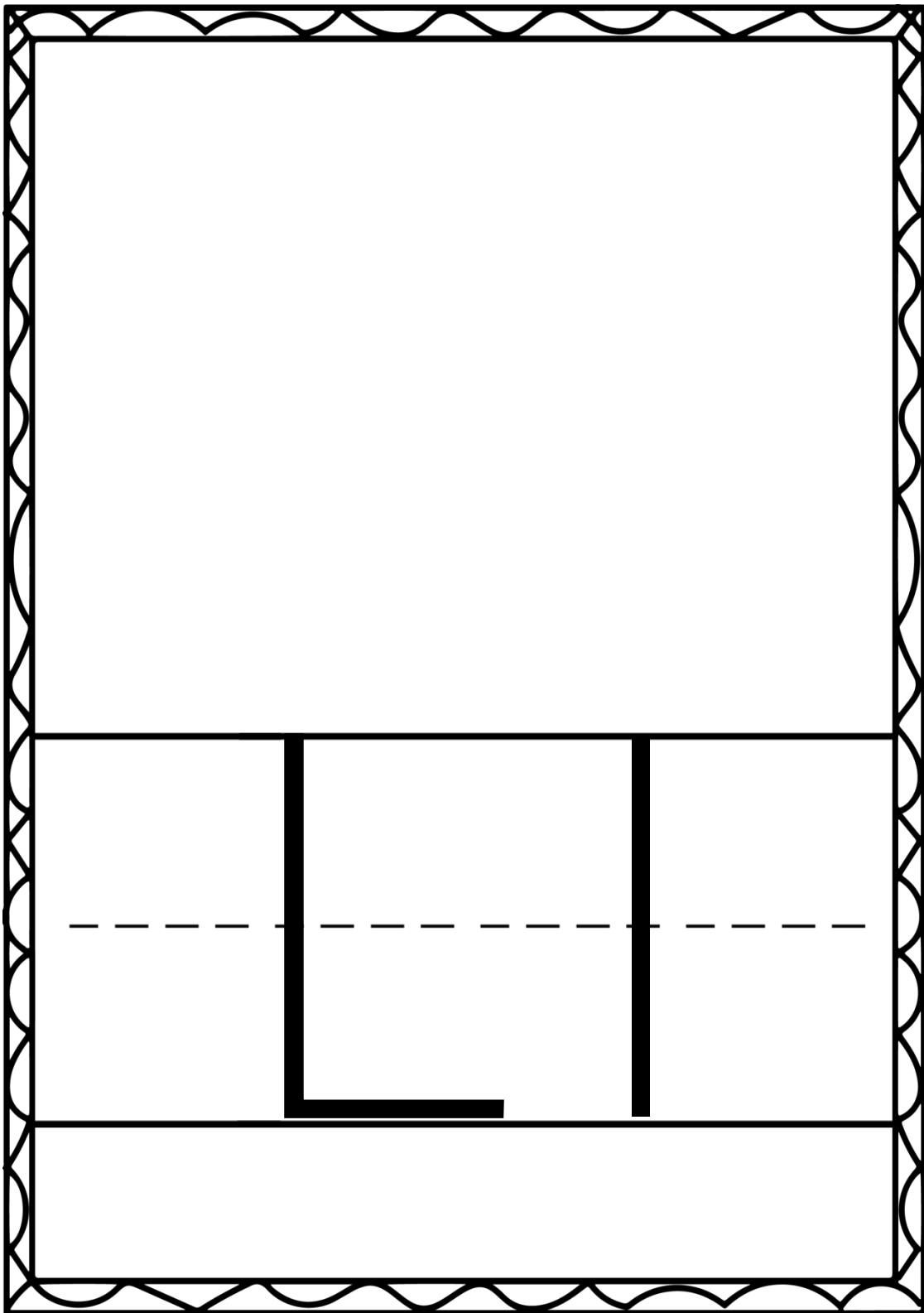


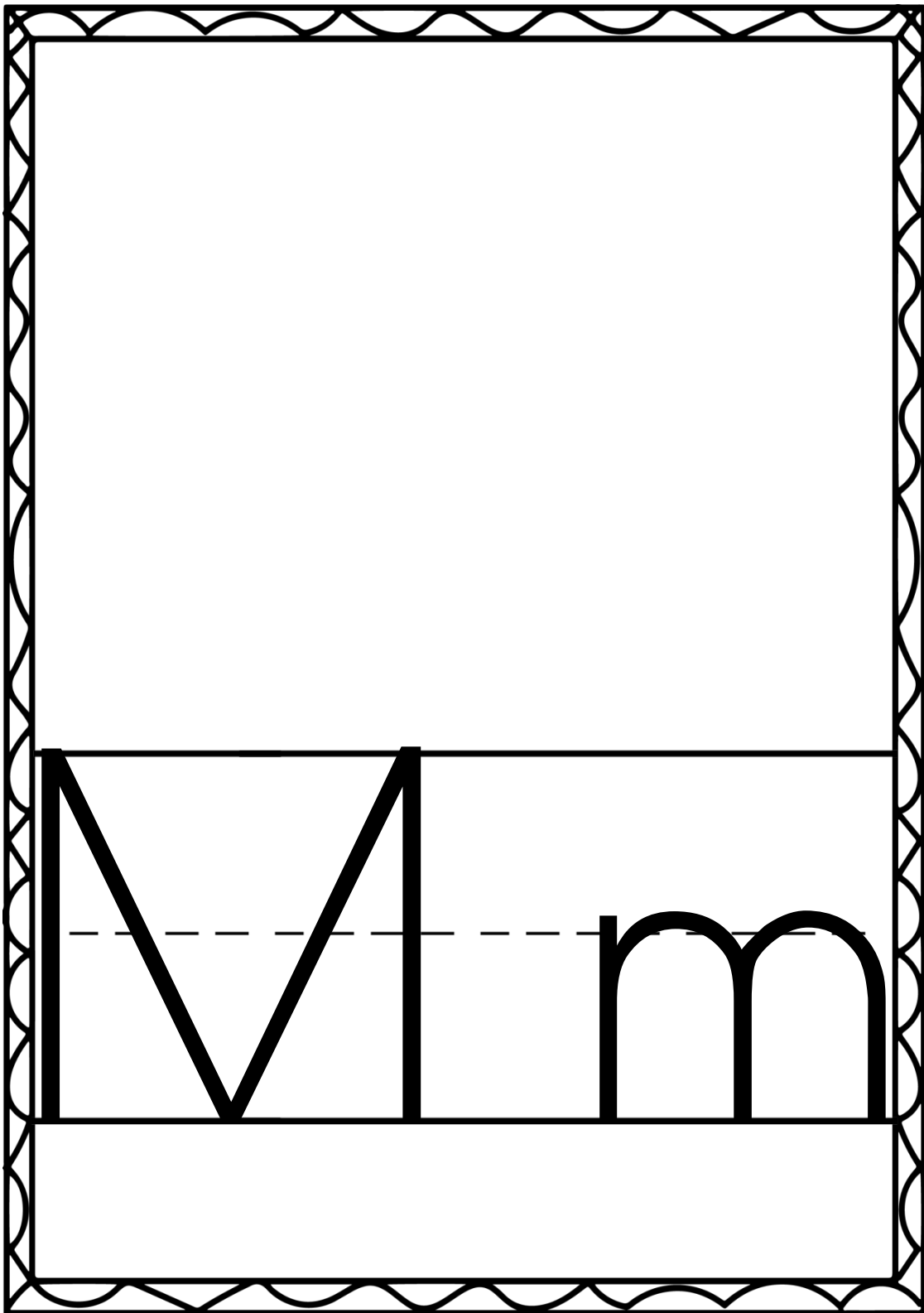


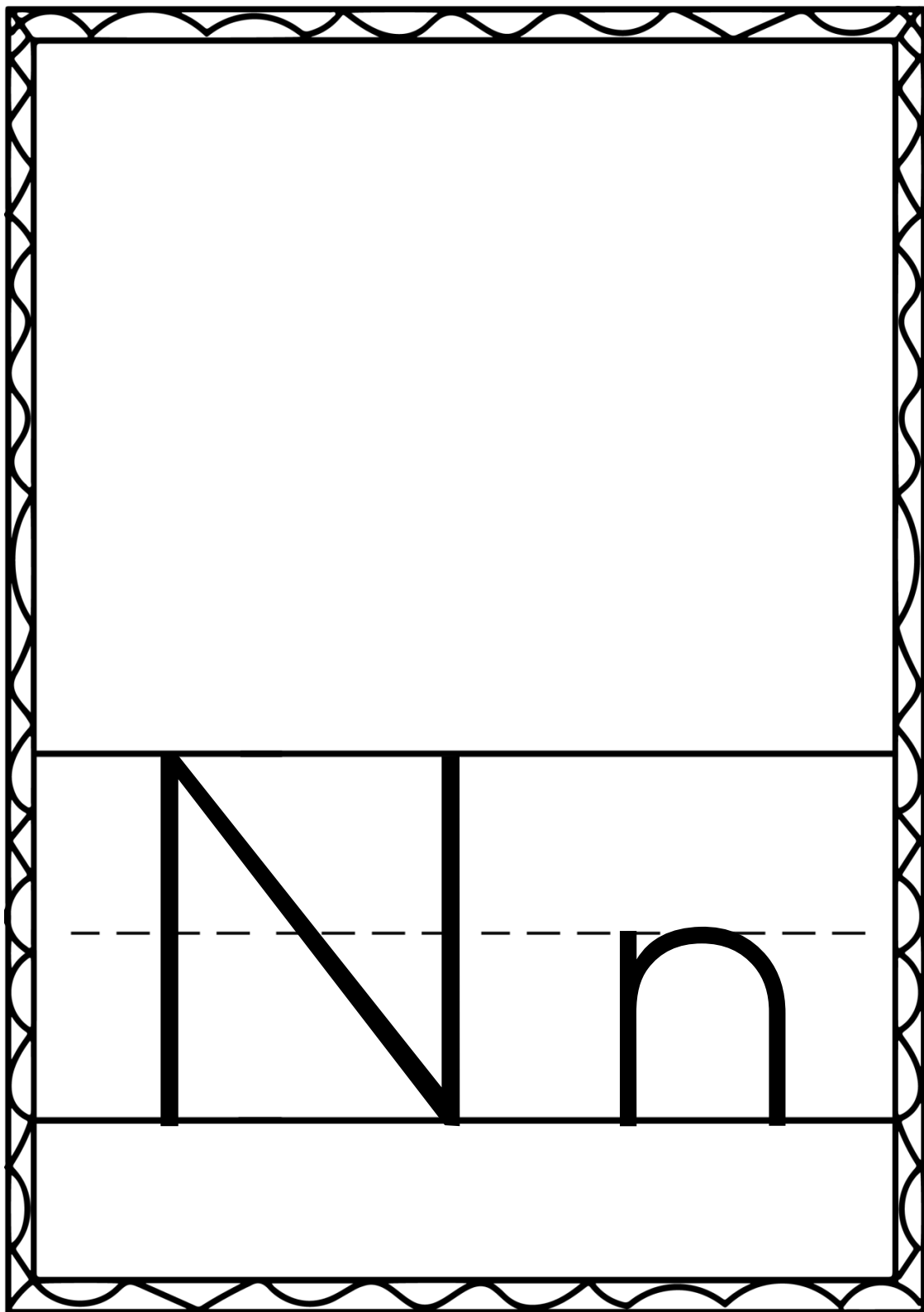


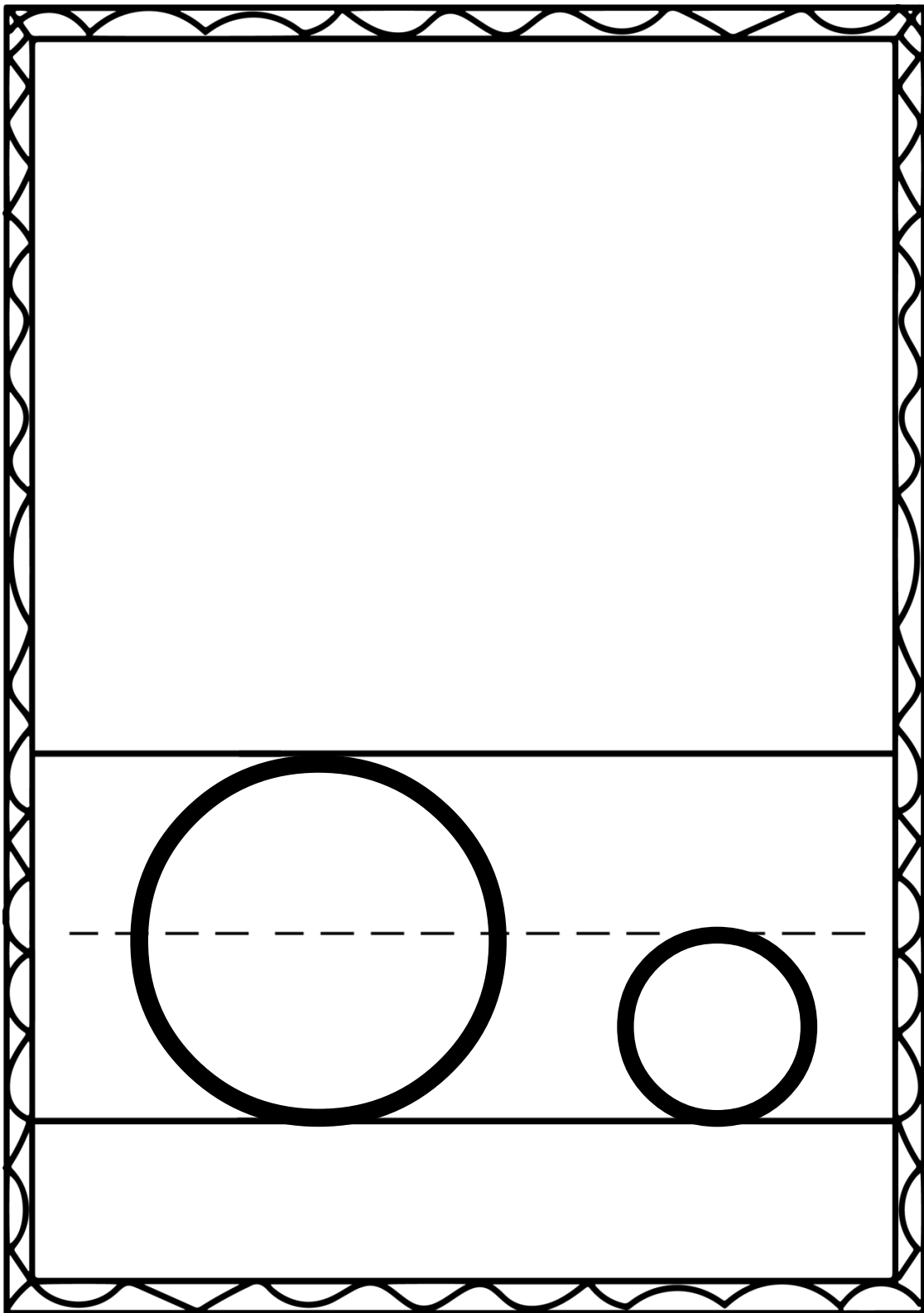


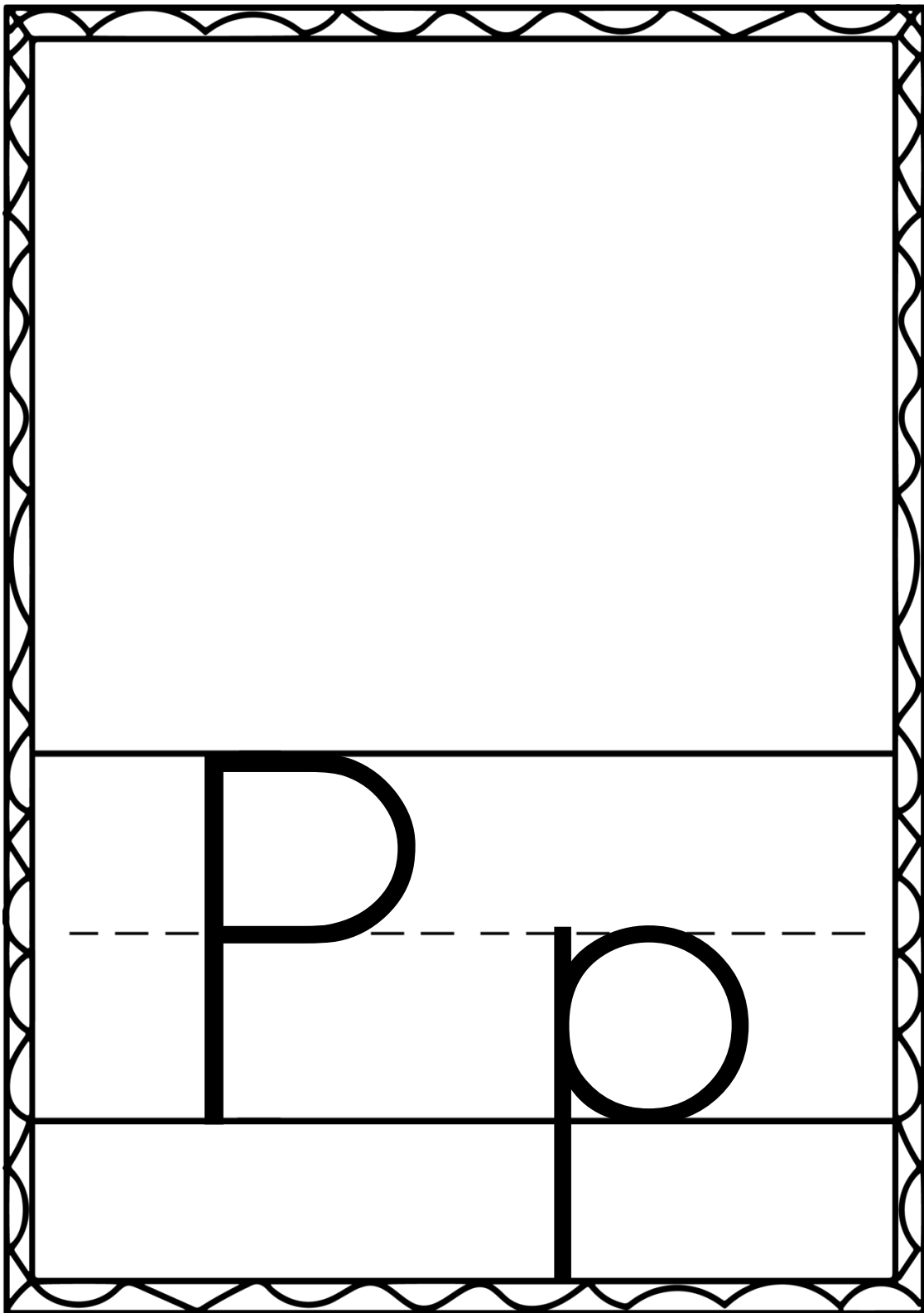


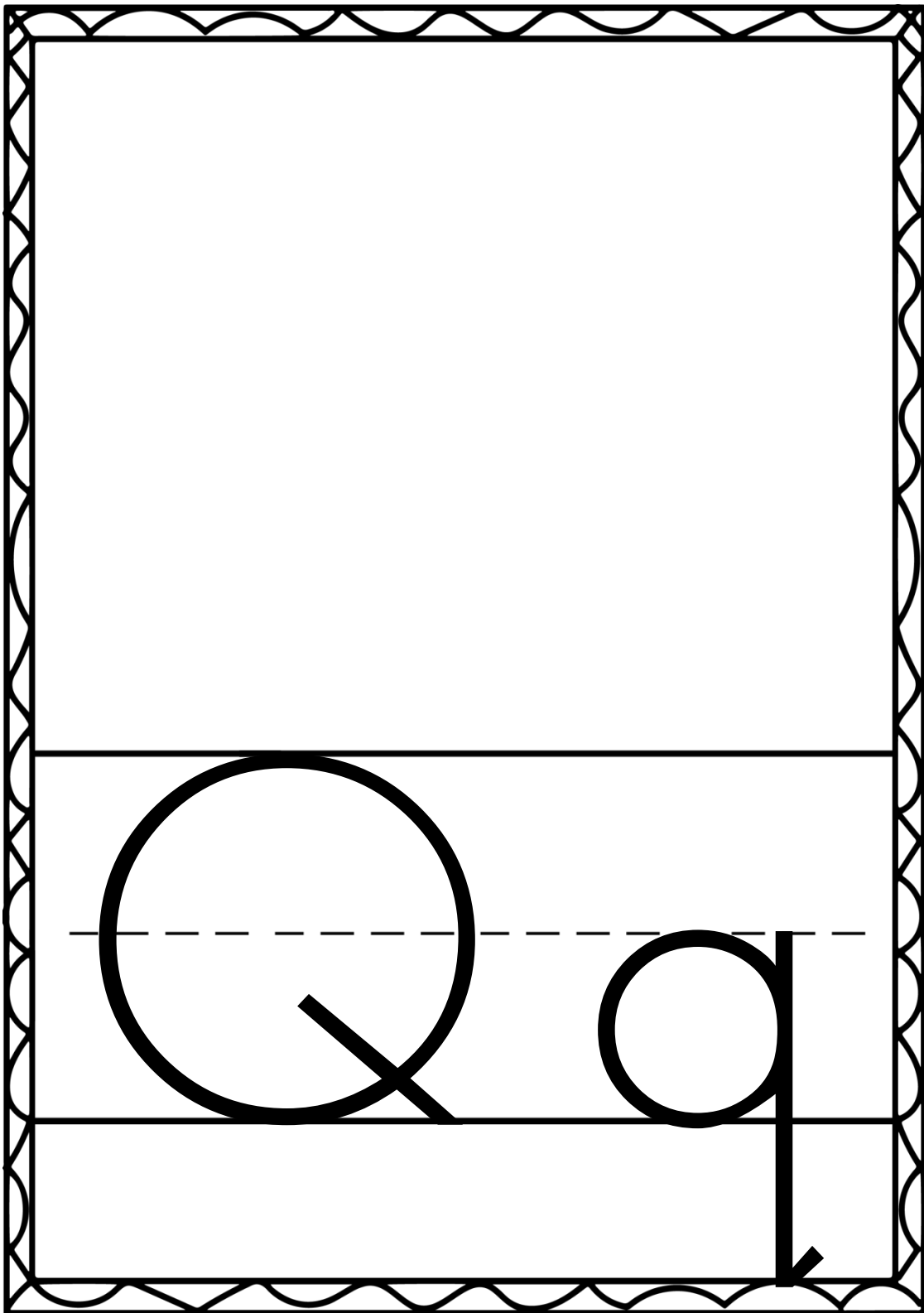


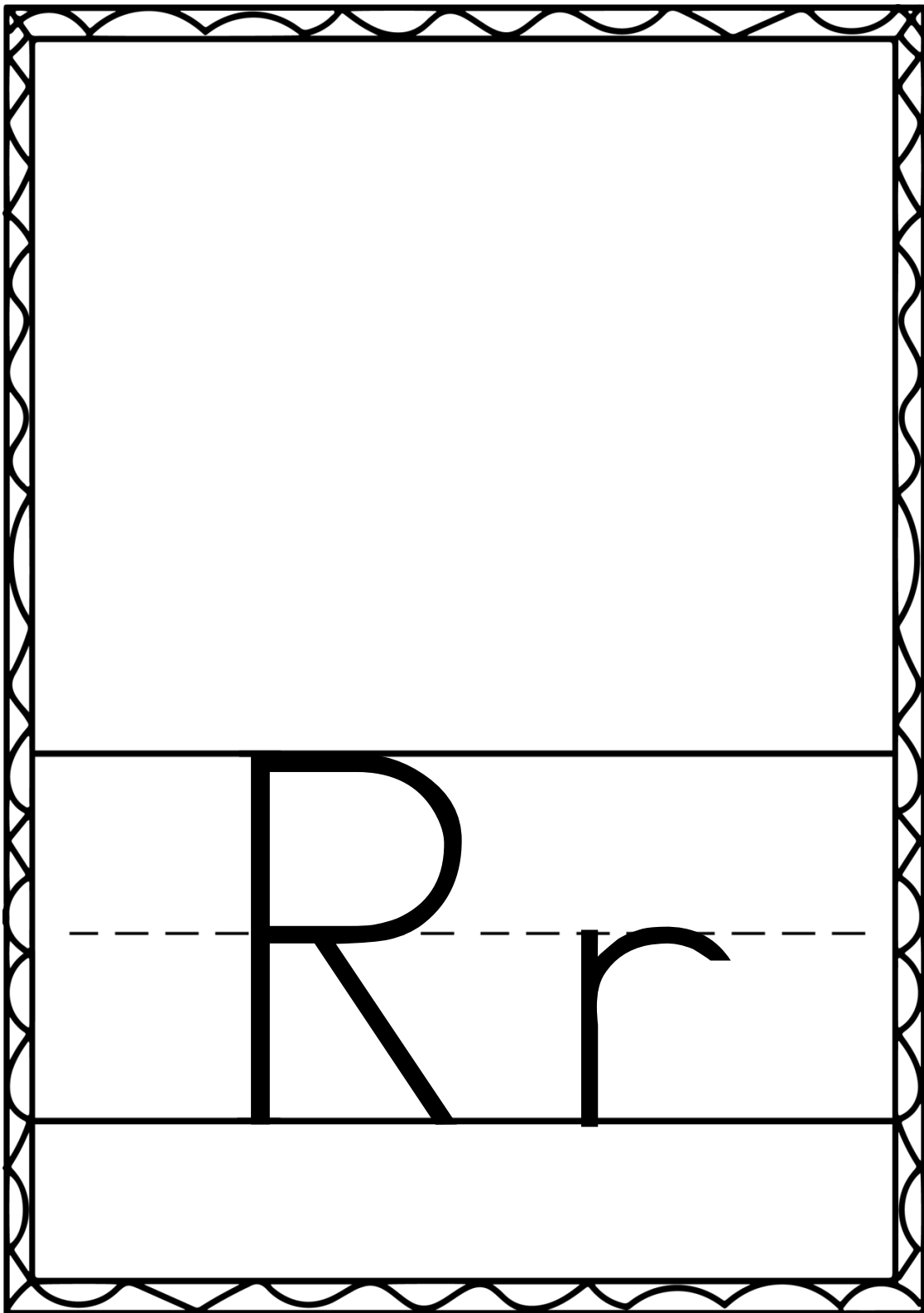


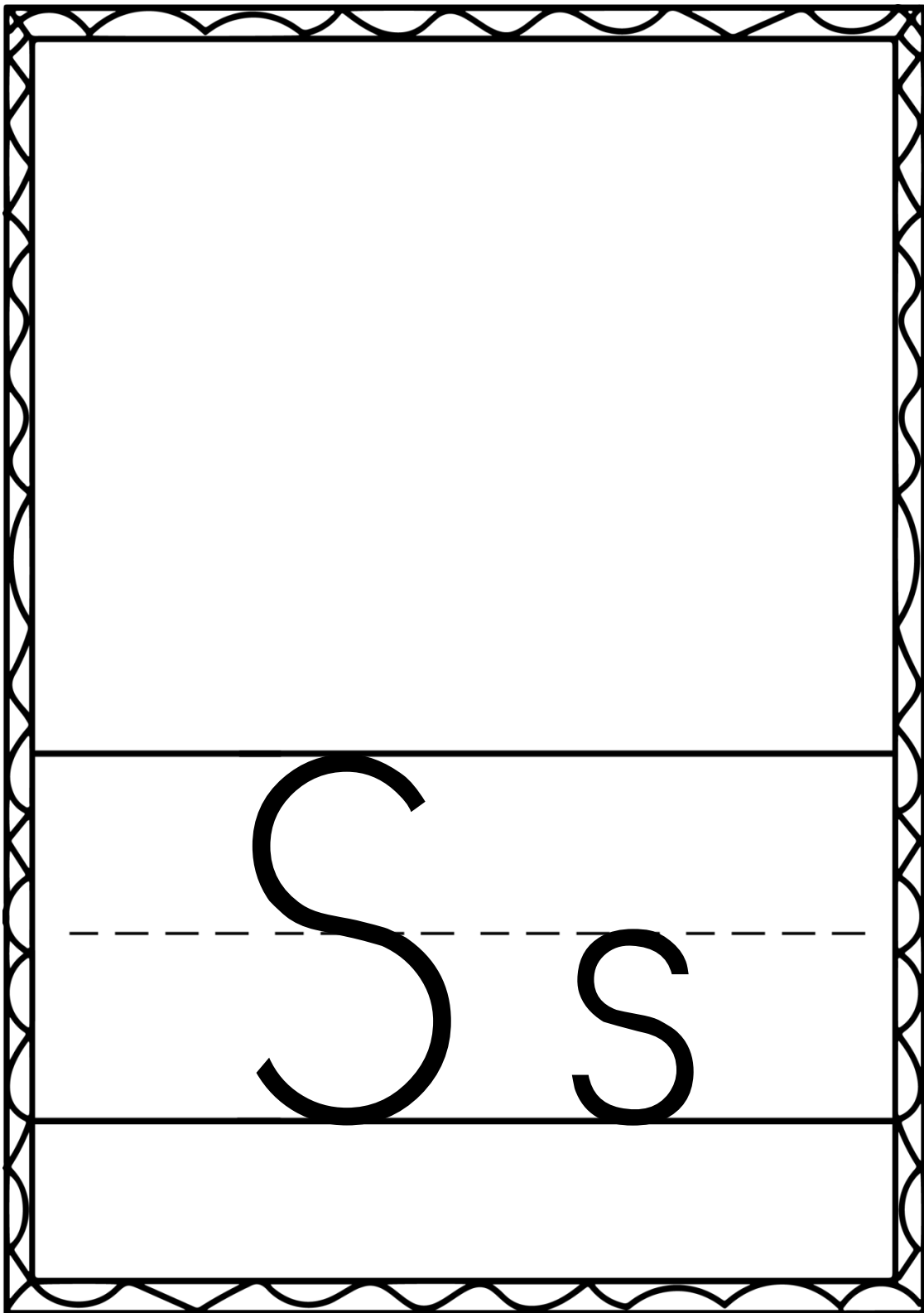


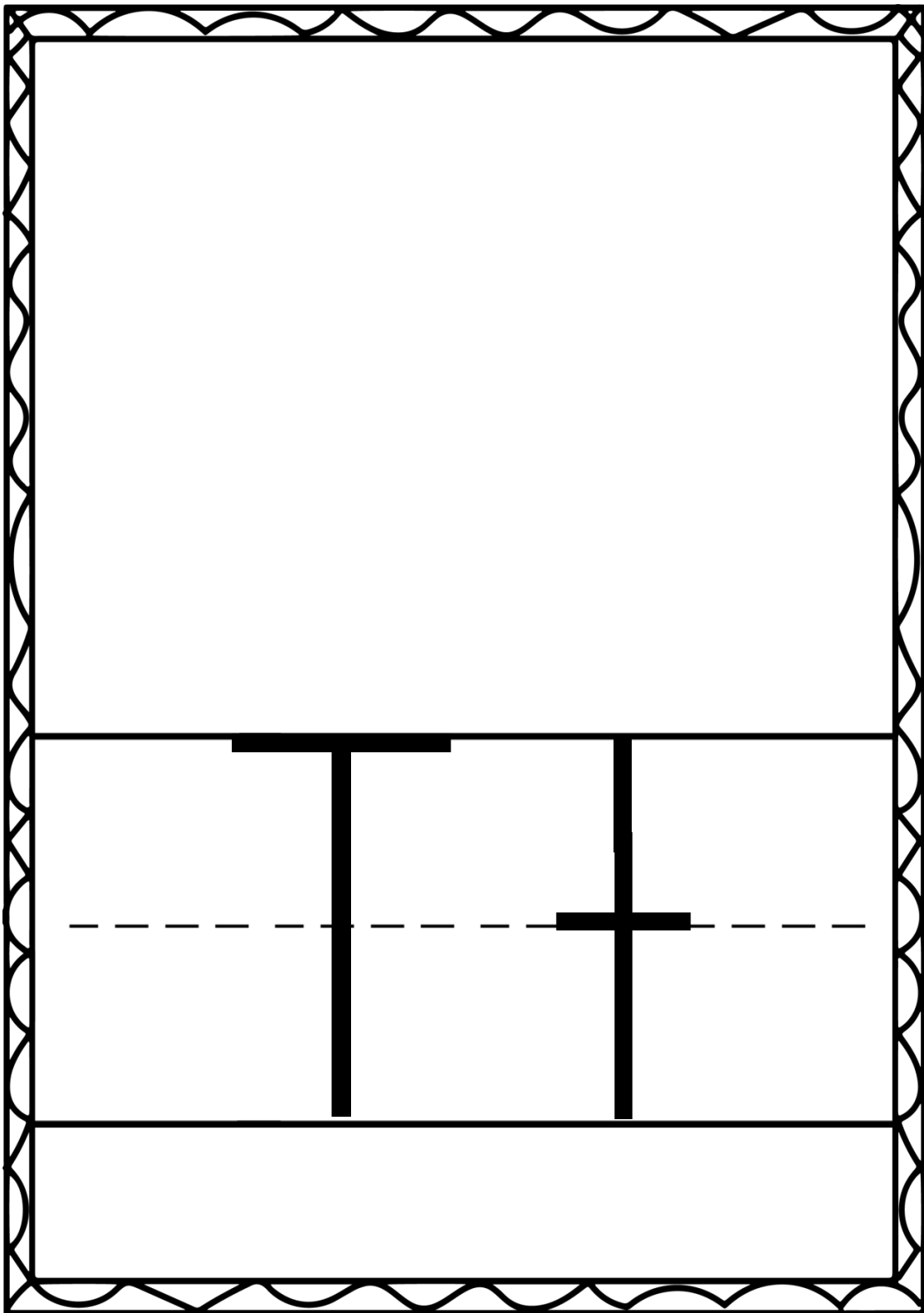


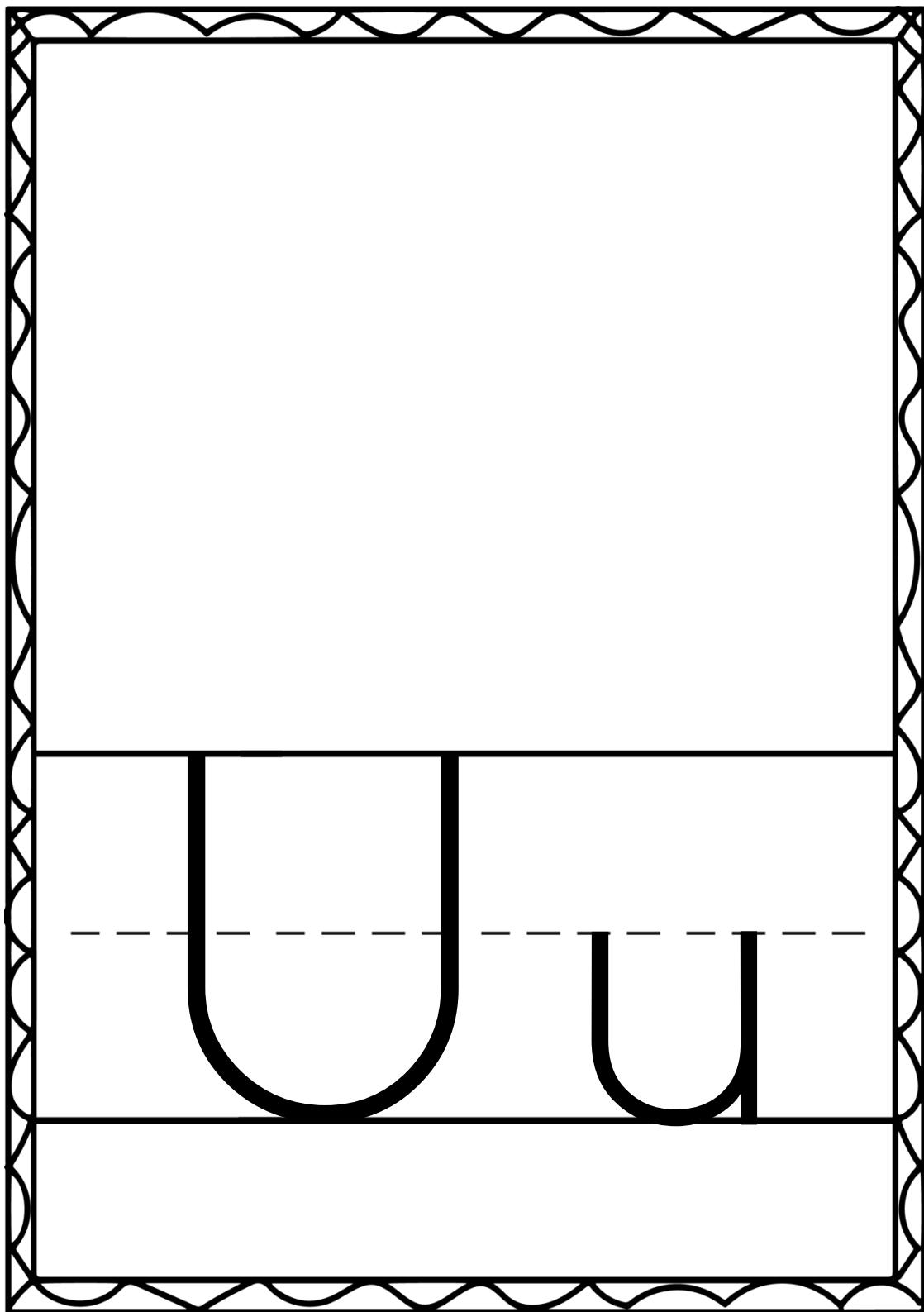


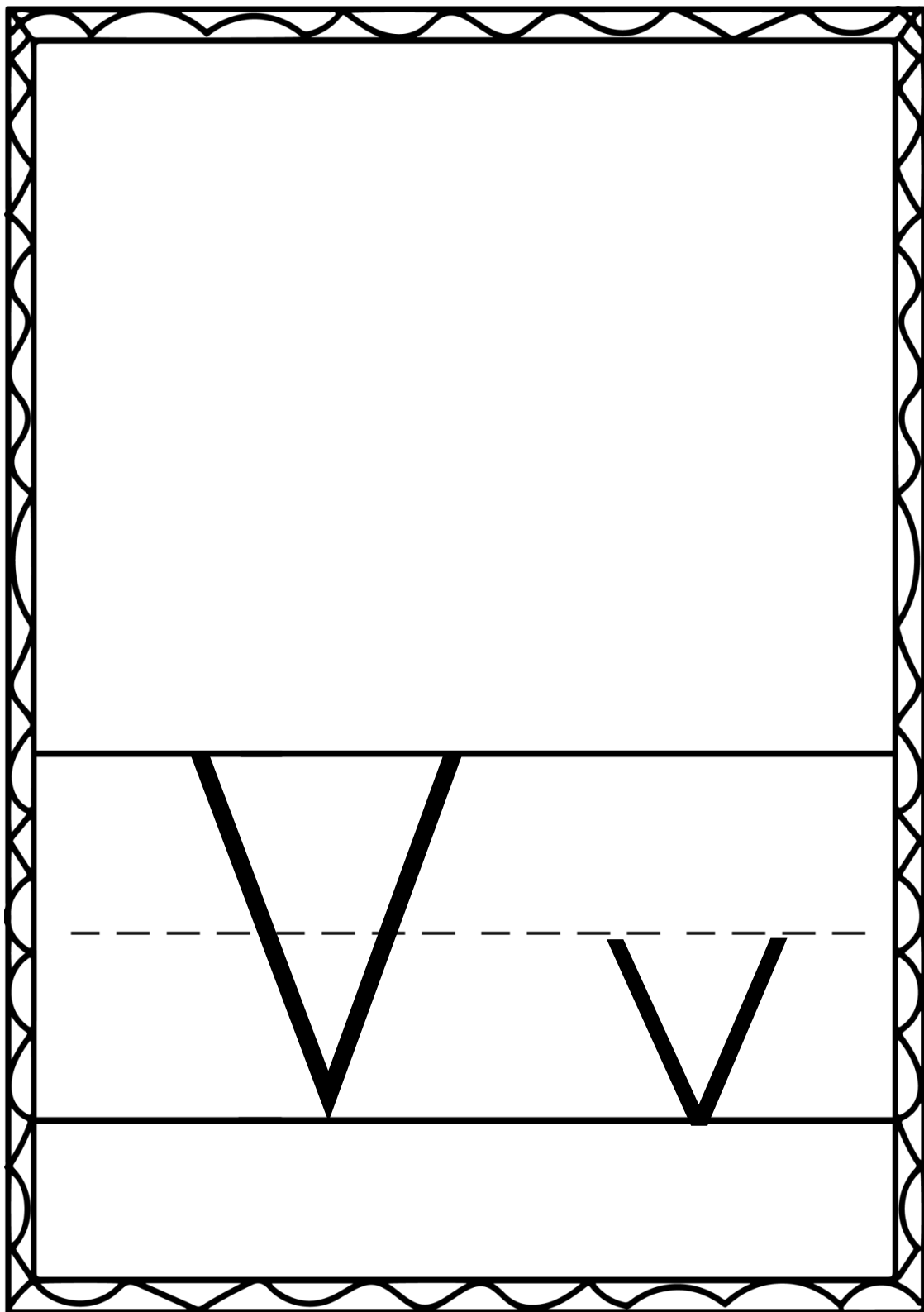


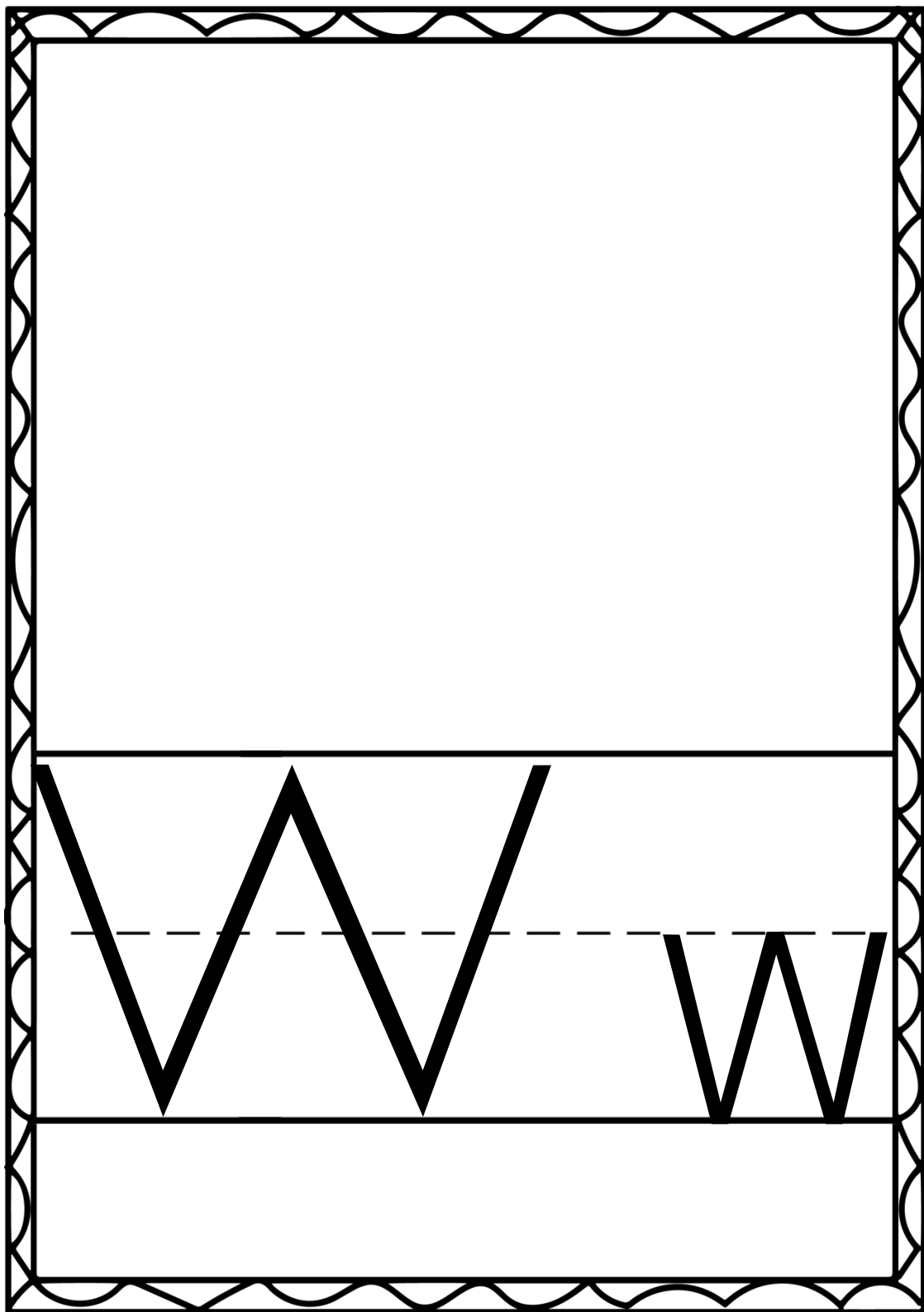


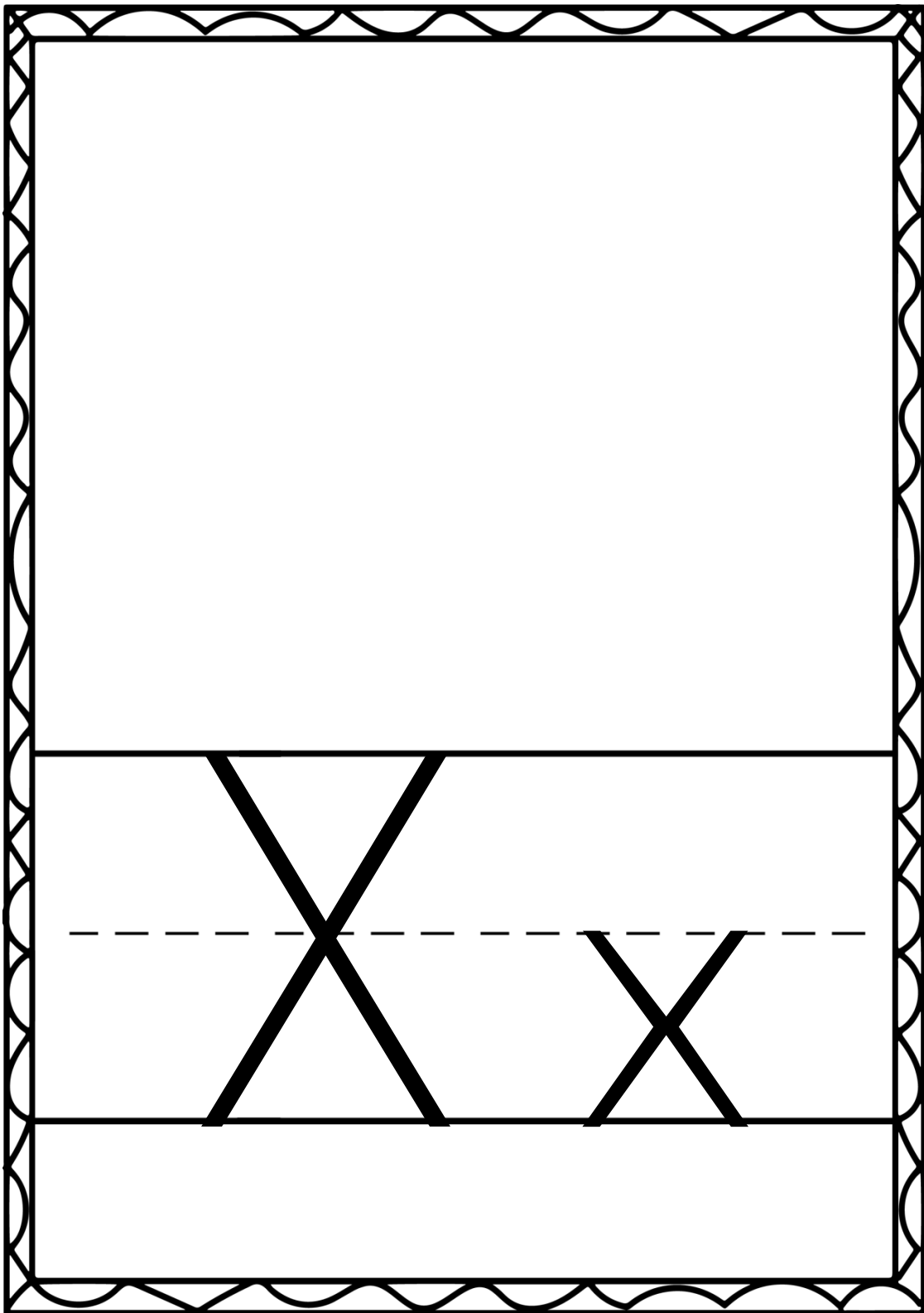


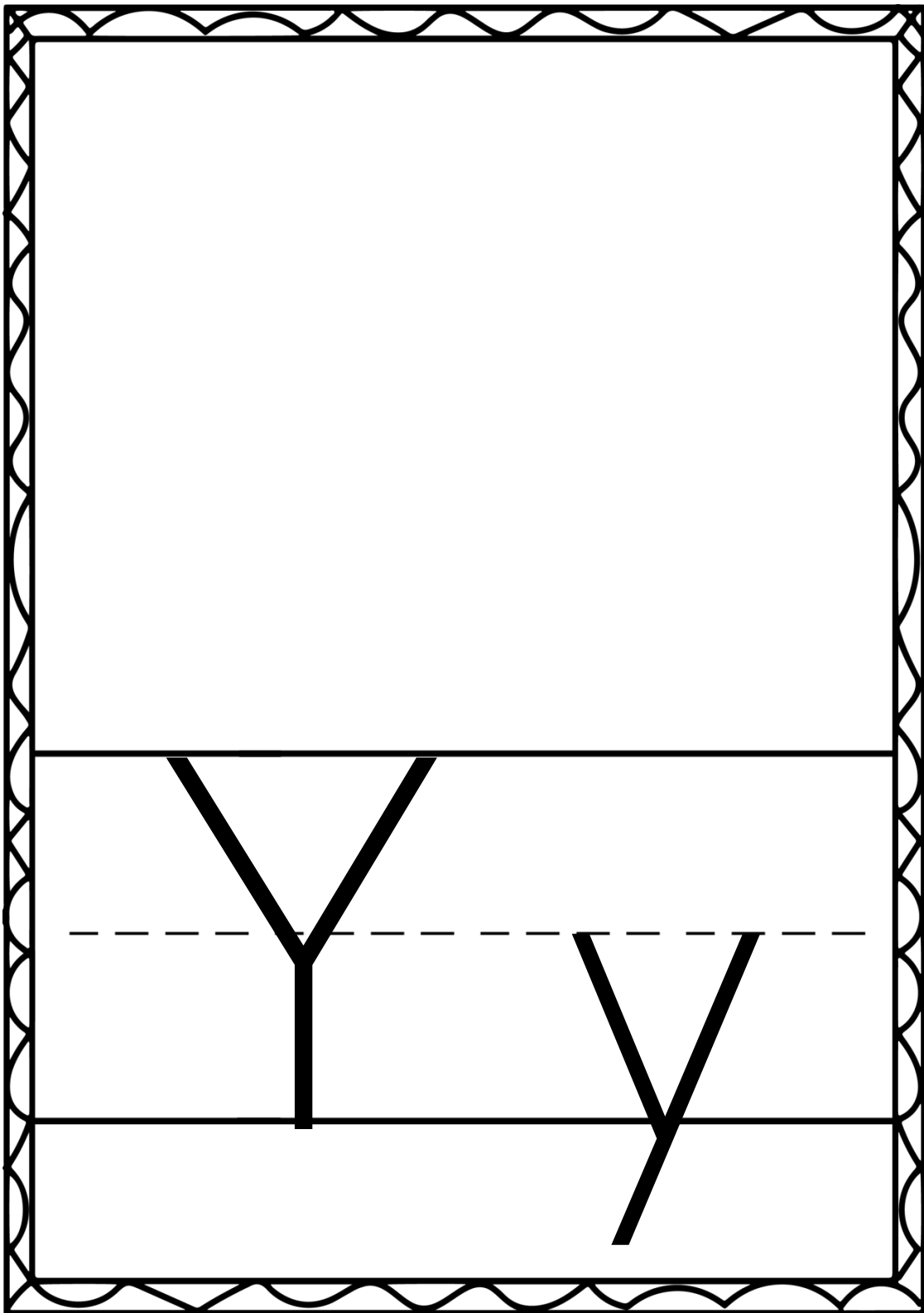


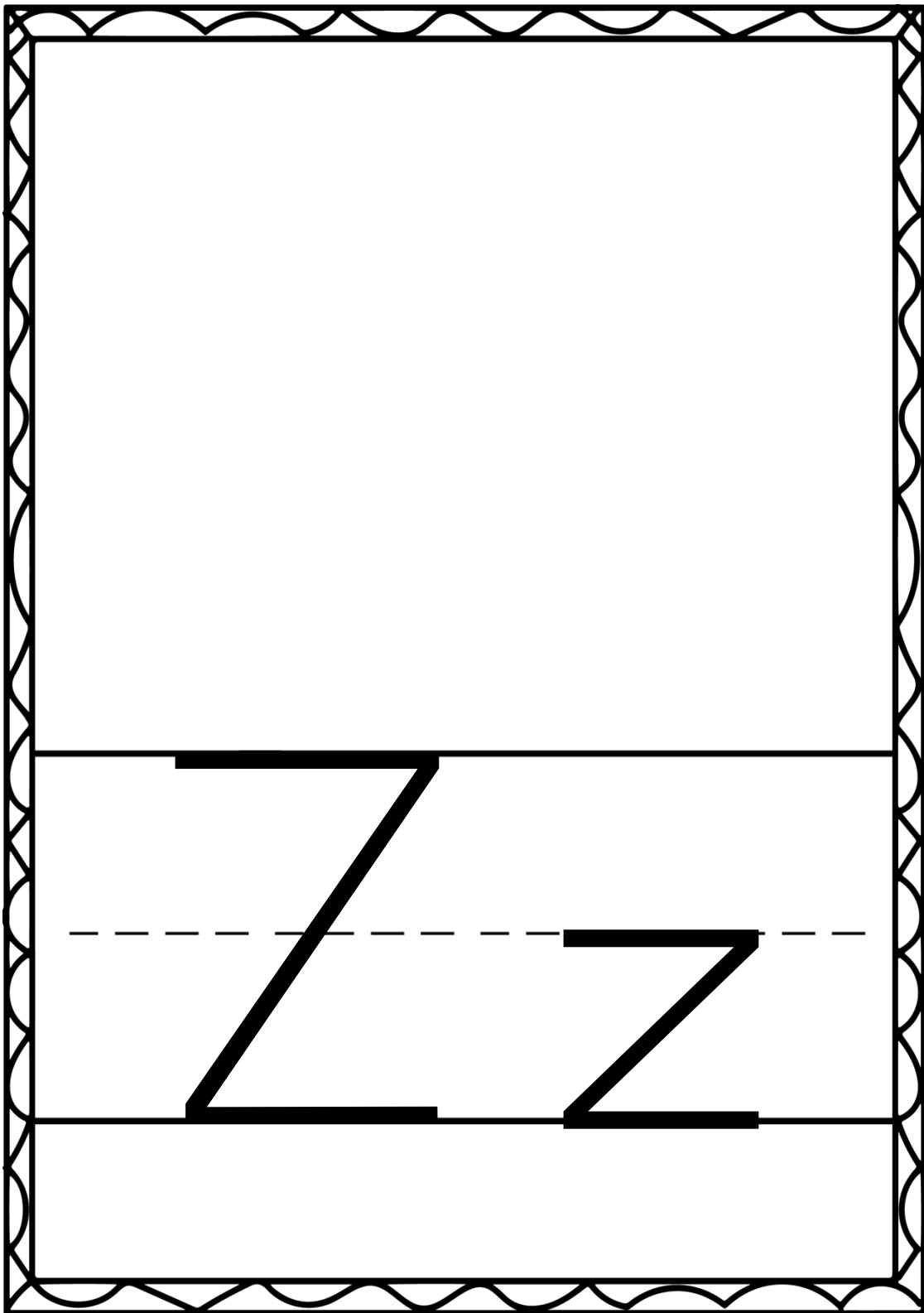


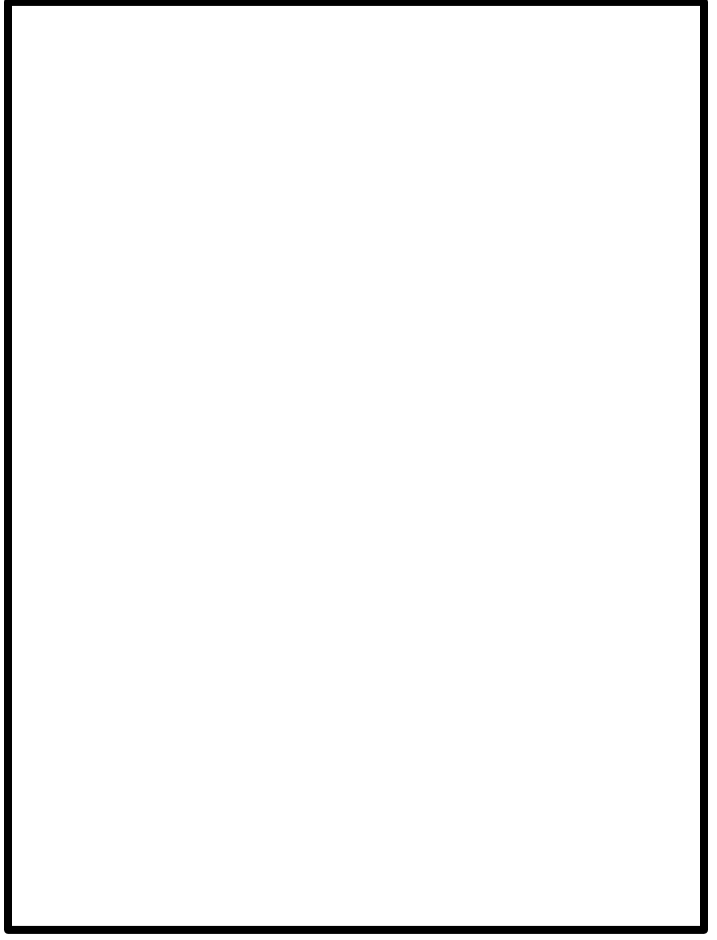
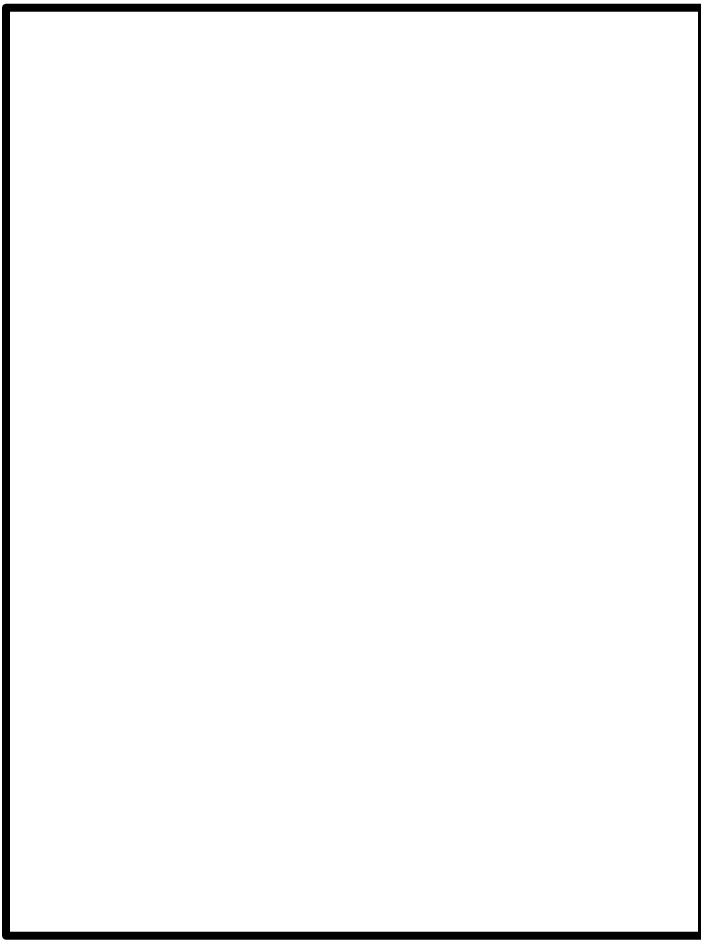
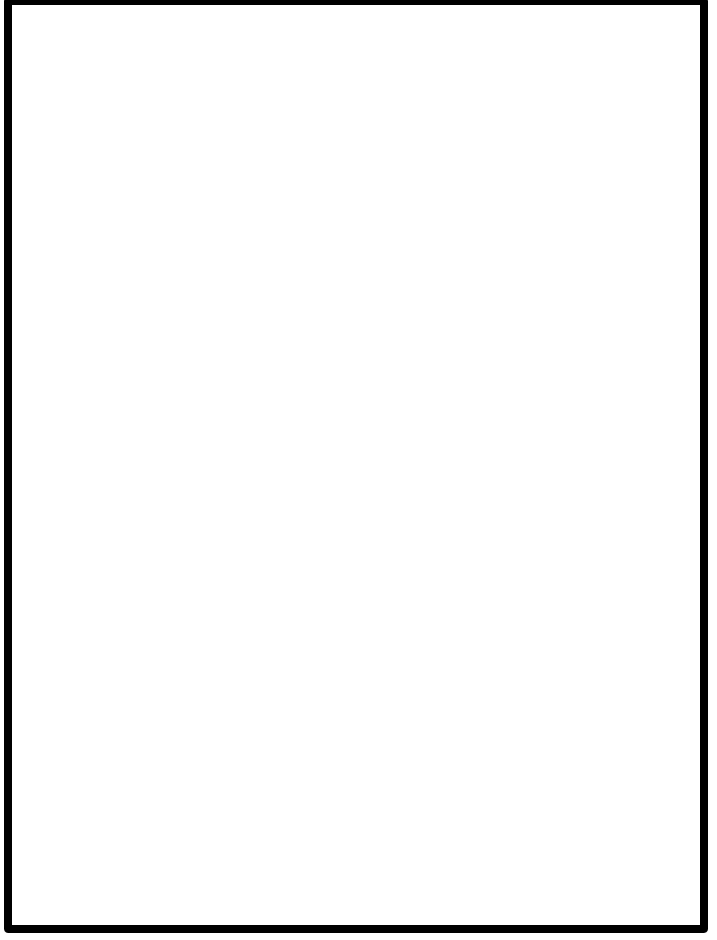
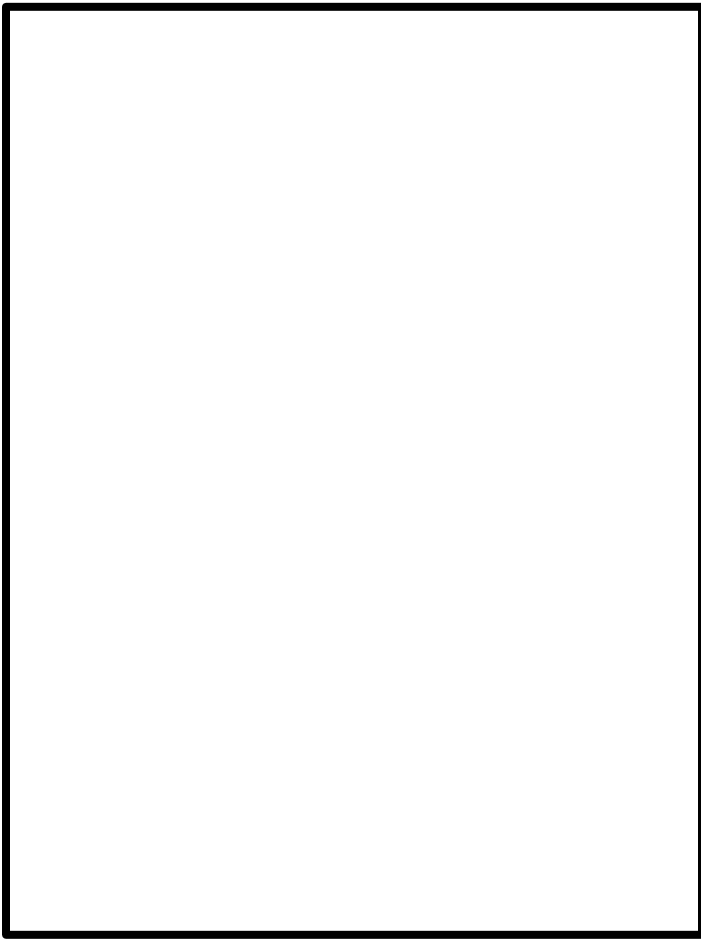



