how to use


I have my students put the puzzle together one of 4 ways:


- U They assemble the puzzle (which I have precut) and if they have time, they can color it.
- 2) I have them color the paper first, cut out the puzzle pieces, * then put it back together.
- 3) Print the colored versions out, have your students cut it into a puzzle, * then they put it back together.
- 4) Print the colored versions out, precut the puzzles before giving them to the students, *
 the students work to put it together.

Includes: I black & white version and 2 colored versions of the puzzle templates shown here (total of 6 puzzles)


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
